## ELEMENTARY DIVISION:



**REUSE-** Projects in this division will focus on the concept of reusing, and its practical applications.

*Examples: Uses for everyday waste, reusable energy, how earth reuses in nature, etc.*

## MIDDLE SCHOOL DIVISION:



**REDUCE-** Projects in this division will focus on reducing our consumption and impact on earth.

*Examples: Composting, preserving natural resources and energy preservation.*

## HIGH SCHOOL DIVISION:



**RETHINK-** Projects in this division will focus on sustainable living at home and in the community.

*Examples: Renewable energy, recycling at home, etc.*
